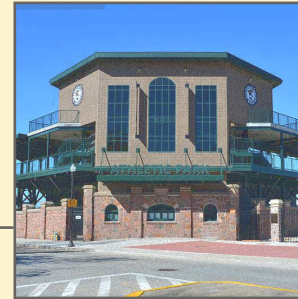


RIVER EDGE TRAIL | 2 and 3-mile walking and running options along the Wisconsin River



Athletic Park

Home of the Wausau Woodchucks, Athletic Park originally opened in 1912 as Yawkey Park. Since 2014 the facility has undergone extensive renovations to enhance the modern ball park experience for both players and guests.



“Vertical Log Raft”

This 30-foot tall sculpture, designed by Manka Design Studios of Cleveland, was commissioned by the Wausau Arts Commission and donated by the Walter Alexander Foundation. The piece pays homage to Wausau’s early involvement in the logging industry along the Wisconsin River.



Barker-Stewart Island

Located on the River Edge Trail between Scott St. and Franklin St. in downtown Wausau, Baker-Stewart Island park is an historic detour you won’t want to miss. The island features lighted gravel walking trails, historic interpretive signs and a pedestrian bridge.

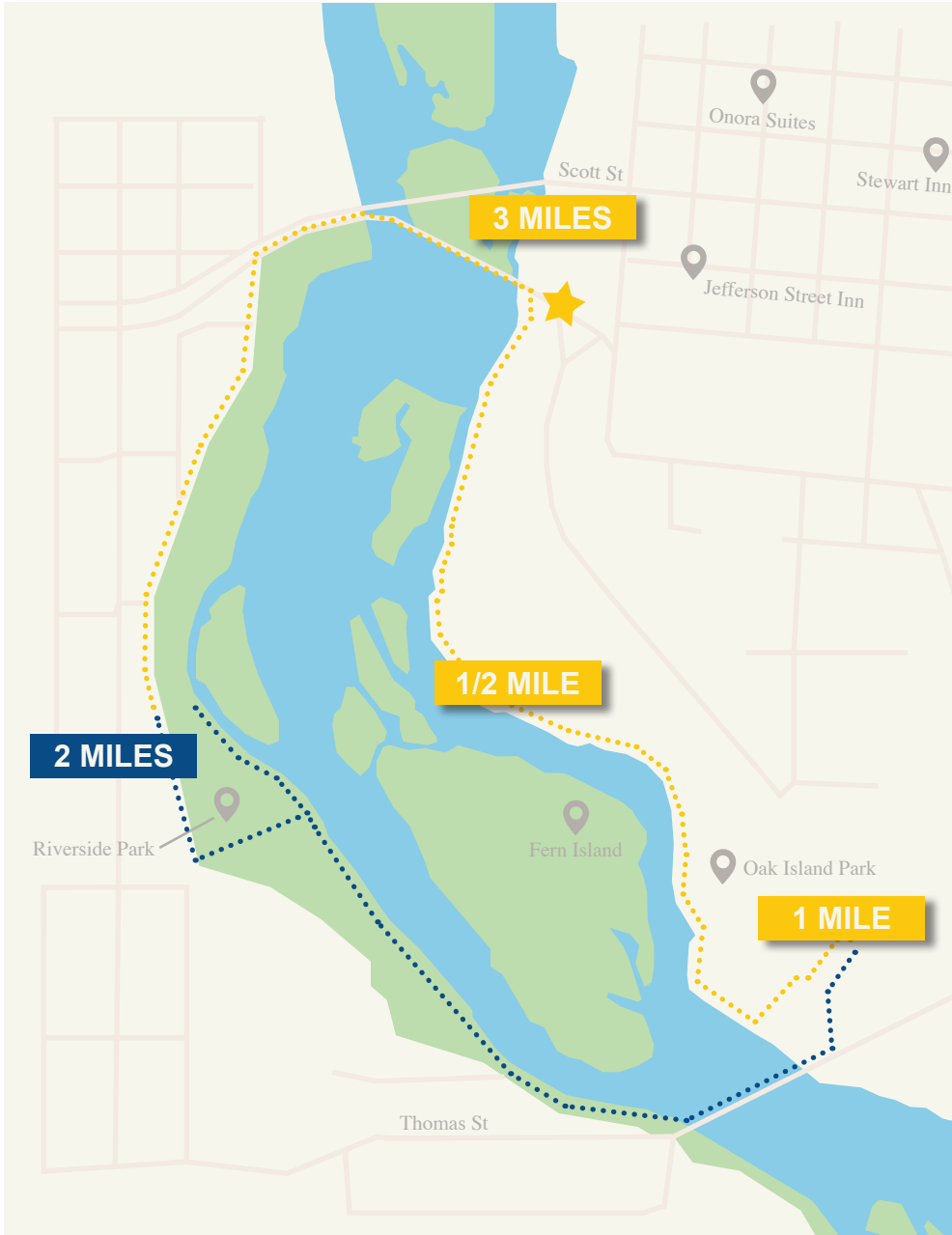


Marathon County Library
